



Falam Keyboard

2026 · Windows PC Guide

This FALAM keyboard (2026) types standard extended-Latin accents plus retroflex ṭ / Ṭ , used in Falam/Mizo orthography.

Windows — Ready to Install (Windows 10 / 11)

Use Falam_Keyboard_Windows_Ready_to_Install.zip:

1. Right-click the ZIP file → Extract All
2. Open the extracted folder
3. Double-click INSTALL_Falam_Keyboard.bat

First run only: Windows may show "Windows protected your PC". Click More info → Run anyway.

4. The installer will automatically download & install AutoHotkey if needed, then set everything up.
5. A green "H" icon appears in your system tray — Falam Keyboard is active!
6. The keyboard starts automatically every time you log in.

To uninstall, double-click UNINSTALL_Falam_Keyboard.bat in the same folder.

How Typing Works (Windows)

Base layout is identical to standard US English. Right Alt (AltGr) + vowel gives circumflex directly. Other accents use Right Alt + accent key.

Right Alt + a/e/i/o/u	—	â ê î ô û (circumflex — direct!)
Right Alt + ' '	a / e / i / o / u	á é í ó ú (acute)
Right Alt + ` <b>`	a / e / i / o / u	à è ì ò ù (grave)
Right Alt + 6 6	a / e / i / o / u	â ê î ô û (circumflex — alt)
Right Alt + [[	a / e / i / o / u / y	ä ë ï ö ü ÿ (diaeresis)
Right Alt + Shift + ` <b>`	a / o / n	ã õ ñ (tilde)
Right Alt + t	—	ṭ
Right Alt + Shift + t	—	Ṭ

□ Tips

- Direct circumflex: Press Right Alt + a/e/i/o/u for instant â/ê/î/ô/û — no dead key needed!
- Dead-key accents: Press Right Alt + accent key, release, then type vowel (for acute, grave, diaeresis, tilde).

- For capitals, use Shift with the vowel (e.g. Right Alt + Shift + A = Â).
- The retroflex ɖ / Ṭ works instantly with Right Alt + t / Right Alt + Shift + t.
- Right Alt = AltGr on most keyboards. If your keyboard has no Right Alt, use Ctrl + Alt.
